FASA usually pays \$75.00 fee per trial per venue, (if judging obedience in the AM and rally in the PM, same day that would be \$150.00 fee. Mileage is paid at the IRS rate. Meals are provided while judging. Hotel rooms are reserved if distance warrants a lay over. We always try to get a nice but inexpensive rate. 
