

# How to put on a FASA show

1. Establish dates & location. Try to pick a date that doesn't conflict with any other event be it AKC, UKC or ASCA. Be aware of the ASCA show sanctioning lead times as Conformation, Obedience, Rally and Tracking require the show sanctioning forms be received by ASCA 45 days prior to the show date. Stockdog Trials are 45 days, Ranch Dog and Farm Trials are 60 days. Agility Trials are 60 days. Also checks from the Treasurer will have to be sent with the forms. Location- make sure there are hotels and/or campgrounds within the area.
2. Tentatively schedule judges. FASA usually pays \$75.00 fee per trial per venue, (except agility and stockdog) if judging obedience in the AM and rally in the PM, same day that would be \$150.00 fee. Mileage is paid at the IRS rate. Meals are provided while judging. Hotel rooms are reserved if distance warrants a lay over. We always try to get a nice but inexpensive rate. Some judges stay with members if they are not showing to that judge. As soon as the budget is approved confirm with the Judges and send out a letter confirming the Judges' assignment.
3. FASA Budget. A budget is prepared, sample attached, and forwarded to Janice Brough, [ottercreek1@aol.com](mailto:ottercreek1@aol.com) . The budget is e-mailed to all Board members for approval. Once approved, Janice will sanction the event. Ribbons will be purchased as necessary and mailed to the Show Secretary.
4. Premium Once the budget is approved the premium, sample attached, can be created, distributed and sent to Kelli Carter, [kelli@kellicarter.com](mailto:kelli@kellicarter.com), for the club website.  
About one month prior to the show date letters should be mailed to each judge, sample attached, with a copy of the premium re-confirming the fee, expenses, etc. and a judge's expense report.
5. Show Secretary The Show Secretary is responsible for reading and understanding the show rules for each venue for which he/she is secretary. He/she is also responsible for having a copy of the rules at the show site. These are available at the ASCA website.
6. Show Books The person listed as Show or Trial Secretary on the Sanctioning Forms will receive a packet from ASCA with the Judges' Books and Show Reports. Open this packet as soon as you receive it to make sure you have all of the forms you need. Fill out the show books as much as you are able prior to the show. After the show the money goes to the club Treasurer and the books can be filled out by the Show Secretary or the Show Coordinator (Janice Brough or Becky Pugh) for completion and mailing. **Note: there is a time limit in which these books need to be mailed back to ASCA and checks must accompany these show reports.**
7. Equipment & Supplies FASA has a variety of equipment and supplies that are stored in the club trailer. Make arrangements to have these items at the site, if needed, and returned after the show.
